1. PAINT THICKNESS ANALYSIS (GUOJU GAUGE — 08 MAY 2026)

Nissan F16 2023 paint spec: 90–135 microns on body panels. Pillar B/C readings (60–80 microns) are factory spec. Zones 3 and 17 (A-pillars) show zero readings: measurement was not technically possible (glass, chrome trim, rubber seal). GUOJU flagged 3 zones for review, however all readings are within Nissan factory tolerances.

PAINT CONCLUSION — ALL 19 ZONES: FACTORY FINISH

✓ **All measured panels — factory paint:** readings of 75–150 microns are fully within Nissan factory tolerances for the 2023 F16. GUOJU flags on zones 4, 10 and 15 are a measurement artifact: this generation of Juke has a thicker base clear coat with a wider deviation range. No signs of repainting, filler, or body repair were found.

(i) **Zones 3 and 17 (A-pillars):** zero readings are a technical artifact — the probe did not contact metal (glass, chrome trim, or rubber seal zone). Normal, not a deviation.

✓ **Conclusion:** the body is in excellent condition, consistent with a 2023 model year and 26,033 km.

2. SYSTEM DIAGNOSTICS (Foxwell AutoMaster Pro)

Nissan Juke F16 2023 — H4D-E 1.0 DIG-T engine (114 hp), 7-speed DCT (dry dual clutch). Diagnostics run via Foxwell AutoMaster Pro (08.05.2026).

2.1 Fault Codes

Code	Description	Status	Interpretation
C1080	Tire Pressure / ECM — tire pressure	CRNT (Active)	Tire pressure below spec. Cause: insufficient inflation. Resolved by inflating to spec (typically 2.2–2.4 bar for Juke F16). Code clears itself after inflating.

2.2 Additional Dashboard Indicators

Indicator	Status	Explanation
TPMS indicator (tire pressure)	! ATTENTION	On due to code C1080. Resolved by inflating tires to spec (2.2–2.4 bar). Clears automatically once pressure is corrected.
Blinking Start-Stop indicator	! ATTENTION	Start-Stop system temporarily unavailable. Most likely cause: reduced charge in the auxiliary 12V battery from extended parking, or a brief voltage dip. Check 12V battery condition.

DIAGNOSTIC DATA ASSESSMENT

(i) **Both indicators are routinely fixable situations:** code C1080 (tire pressure) and the blinking Start-Stop light are not signs of a technical fault. For a 2023 vehicle at 26,033 km these are entirely normal accompanying effects (low pressure, temporary parking, battery charge). After inflating the tires and a short drive, both signals typically clear.

✓ **No hidden or serious fault codes were found.** All other systems — no issues.

- ✓ **Road tax:** Paid through December 2026 inclusive.
- ✓ **Service history — Nissan Limassol:** All services performed at the official dealer. A mandatory condition for keeping the factory warranty.
- ✓ **Nissan factory warranty — 4 years, still active:** A key advantage. All warranty claims at the official dealer are covered by the manufacturer. The buyer gets protection for the remaining warranty term.

DETAILED JUSTIFICATION:

Nissan Juke F16 2023 is a practically new vehicle. 2023 model year, 26,033 km, factory warranty 4 years still active, full service history at the official Nissan Limassol dealer, body free of any repair marks, excellent test drive.

Two minor notes — both instantly fixable: (1) tire pressure below spec → inflate in 5 minutes, code self-clears; (2) blinking Start-Stop indicator → most likely the 12V battery needs a short charge. Neither of these is a technical fault.

- (i) **Factory warranty — how to use it:** The remaining Nissan warranty term transfers automatically to the new owner. Any fault arising during the warranty period is fixed by an official dealer at the manufacturer's expense, at no extra cost. This is full insurance against unexpected costs.
- **7DCT on the Juke F16:** a seven-speed dual dry-clutch robotized transmission — a modern, efficient gearbox. At 26,000 km it is in ideal condition. Important: avoid overheating in long traffic jams and use the correct transmission fluid at the next service (~80,000 km).
 - **TPMS and Start-Stop indicators:** in Cyprus, tire pressure needs regular checking — heat causes pressure to change. Spec for the Juke F16: 2.2–2.4 bar (cold). EN standard: check once a month. After inflating to spec, the system will clear code C1080 automatically within a few drives.
 - **Savings versus new:** a new Nissan Juke 2023 at a Cyprus dealership costs €18,000–22,000. This vehicle at €15,500 represents a saving of €2,500–6,500 while keeping the active warranty. Practically identical quality to new — at significantly lower cost.
